## **Waste Management Plan**

Proposal: Residential Flat Building

Address of Development: 6-8 Grant Street, Maitland

## **Construction and Earthworks Stage**

The waste will be separated on site by builder's contractors and builder's labourers during the construction stage. The site will be checked on a regular basis to make sure no recyclable materials are mixed with non-recyclable materials, and to set aside on site an area to store the recyclable materials for transportation to local recycling plants.

The site manager will erect a sign on site for waste areas and will inform the builder's staff where material is to be collected for recycling. The site manager and/or builder will impose the execution of the waste separation policy on a regular basis and to have on-going checks.
