Parking Fine Report

Background:

In accordance with the Fine Act 1996 and the Fines Amendment (Parking Fines) Act 2024, Maitland City Council is required to report on parking fines issued each quarter and then every six months.

The NSW Government's reforms to the parking fine system, which came into effect on 01 July 2025 require councils to:

- Attach a parking fine or notification to the vehicle (except in limited circumstances),
- Provide photographic evidence of the offence to Revenue NSW,
- Issue fines within seven days of the offence occurring and
- Publicly report data on parking fines issued.

The changes aim to restore fairness and transparency to the parking fine system across NSW.
