Your Three Bin System

Children will learn about what can go in each of the kerbside bins and participate in a mini-waste audit using everyday waste materials.

Composting and Worm Farming

This workshop provides staff and children with information on setting up a worm farm or compost bin, what materials can be placed in them, and ways we can reduce food waste.

Available from May to June 2026



Our Biodiversity

This workshop will provide children with the opportunity to explore what makes up our local environment and the different creatures that live in our region.

Available from July to September 2026



Water Pollution

Children will learn where our water comes from and participate in a hands-on demonstration of what can happen to our local waterways if pollutants are allowed into them.

Available from October to December 2026.
